EXPLORE YULARA AND BEYOND

STICK TO THE SEALED ROADS ON THIS 5-DAY EXPLORATION.

DAY ONE

Fly into Yulara, hire a car and head north east on the Lasseter's Highway. Turn off the highway near Curtin Springs to take the scenic drive through to Kings Creek Station. At Kings Creek Station you can stay in permanent canvas tents with a lovely outlook over the landscape the perfect place for sunset. Just 5 minutes down the road is Karrke Indigenous experience, book this in the afternoon for a fabulous experience. Just ask reception at Kings Creek to be pointed in the right direction, and know you can get in on a 2WD. Enjoy dinner at Kings Creek station, but check the times and book ahead.

DAY TWO



You can head to Kings Canyon (bitumen all the way) and either experience the walking trails and stay overnight at Kings Canyon o do the sunrise rim walk. Either settle in and set up camp for the night, or enjoy being pampered at the resort.

DAY THREE

Head back towards Yulara and stop at Curtin Springs for the paper tour, station walk and a meal under the original homestead roof. If you'd like to stay the night, there are cabins available.



DAY FOUR



Book into the campground or resort accommodation at Yulara, and ensure you have booked on the Field of Lights sunset tour - before March 2018 (\$80) - Not only do you see the sunset on Uluru you see the desert come alive with lights from Brian Munro's art installation, it truly is a magical experience.

DAY FIVE



Up early today to see sunrise at Uluru for another spectacular natural show! Afterwards head to do the Valley of the Winds walk at Kata Tjuta. Enjoy a well-deserved lunch later that day and reflect on a truly enriching experience in the heart of the nation. Sadly, it's then time to fly out!
