VISIT THE ICONIC ULURU AND SEE THE REAL OUTBACK

DAY ONE



Fly into Yulara Hire a 4WD, ideally with a tent so you can camp under millions of stars in the beautiful outback or if that's not your style book into a 4 star resort in the area. Spend the afternoon enjoying the Yulara town centre, and of course the sunset.

DAY TWO



Head to Kata Tjuta - the Olga's and turn west on the Docker River Rd. Note the roads are gravel from here until Docker River. On the way you'll find stunning pictures of the Olga's in your review mirror and the everchanging landscape is spectacular. Stop in at Lasseter's Cave- the iconic explorer - and find some treasure of your own! Note that this is a geocache site for those following our treasure hunt! Docker River has a store and a new Art Gallery, you can pull up at the Docker River campground situated under the Desert Oaks with very basic facilities or keep heading to Warakurna - travel in the valley of the Musgrave and Peterman ranges- very impressive. Warakurna has units and a camp ground to stay in. Note they are on NT time and it's best to book ahead and arrange dinner.

DAY THREE

At Warakurna find the sort after Artwork in the Roadhouse, it's very good and by local Artists. Head up to the Giles Weather Station and see Len Beadell's grader, the man that made the road. Head back to Docker River for a night.



DAY FOUR



Back into Yulara and today and then off home.
