



**ACROSS AUSTRALIA & THE KIMBERLEY with**  
**4WD TAG ALONG TOUR**  
**COMMENCING IN WINTON QLD & ENDING LAKE ARGYLE WA**  
**30 MAY - 28 JUNE 2022**

**DAY 1 – MON 30 MAY (D)**

**4.30pm** - Meet in the front bar of the North Gregory Hotel – Graham’s shout for 1<sup>st</sup> drink!  
Dinner across the road at the Tattersalls Hotel.  
Overnight at North Gregory Hotel, Winton

**DAY 2 – TUE 31 MAY (D) (361km)**

Drive to Boulia via Middleton and Cawnpore Lookout  
Dinner will be a short walk down the road at the Australian Hotel.  
Overnight at Desert Sands Motel, Boulia

**DAY 3 – WED 1 JUNE (D) (686km)**

Travel west via the Donohue & Plenty Highway to Gemtree.  
Overnight at Gemtree Caravan Park  
Dinner this evening in the Campoven Kitchen

**DAY 4 – THU 2 JUNE (D) (220km)**

Drive via the East MacDonnell Ranges to Ross River Homestead  
Some free time this afternoon.  
Overnight at Ross River Homestead  
Dinner in the dining room

**DAY 5 – FRI 3 JUNE (D) (83km)**

Drive into Alice Springs – free time.  
Suggestions: Old Telegraph Station, RFDS, Desert Park, National Transport Museum  
Overnight at Quest Alice Springs  
Dinner – details to be advised

**DAY 6 – SAT 4 JUNE (D) (357km)**

Travel via the West MacDonnell Ranges and following the Mereenie Loop (Red Centre Way) to Kings Canyon  
Includes Stanley Chasm walk  
Overnight at Kings Canyon Resort including ‘Dinner Under A Desert Moon’

**DAY 7 – SUN 5 JUNE (B, D) (303km)**

Buffet breakfast included.  
10am – Smoko (byo) at start of the Kings Canyon rim walk.  
Depart Kings Canyon and travel via Curtin Springs to Ayers Rock Resort.  
“Field of Lights” tour included.  
Accommodation: Desert Gardens, Ayers Rock Resort (Garden View Rooms) x 2 nights

**DAY 8 – MON 6 JUNE (D)**

Day at leisure.  
Meet for dinner this evening at Gecko’s Restaurant.

**DAY 9 – TUE 7 JUNE (D) (336km)**

Continue west via Docker River to the Aboriginal community of Warakurna.  
Overnight at Warakurna Roadhouse.

**DAY 10 – WED 8 JUNE (D) (450km)**

Today we visit Surveyor Generals Corner enroute to Warburton  
Overnight at Warburton Roadhouse

**DAY 11 – THU 9 JUNE (D)** (670km)

On the last leg of the Outback Way we travel to Laverton & then Leonora  
Overnight at Central Hotel, Leonora  
Dinner at hotel

**DAY 12 – FRI 10 JUNE (D)** (485km)

Time this morning to take a look around Gwalia ‘Ghost Town’  
Head to Meekatharra via Wiluna  
Overnight at the Royal Mail Hotel, Meekatharra

**DAY 13 – SAT 11 JUNE (B, D)** (412km)

Continental breakfast included before we head onto Newman  
2pm –Mt Whaleback Tour – The World’s Largest Open Cut Iron Ore Mine \*\* (included)  
\*\* Must wear long pants, long sleeves & closed in shoes  
Overnight at Newman Visitor Centre Chalets  
Dinner at Newman Hotel

**DAY 14 – SUN 12 JUNE (D)** (313km)

Travel onto Karijini National Park – time for exploring  
Overnight Karijini Eco Retreat in Deluxe Eco Tents  
Dinner this evening the in Outback Style Restaurant

**DAY 15 – MON 13 JUNE (B, D)** (420km)

Travel to Port Hedland via Tom Price & Wittenoom  
Overnight at the Discovery Park, Port Hedland

**DAY 16 – TUE 14 JUNE (D)** (250km)

Harbour Tour Talk & 30 – 45-minute cruise out to vessels returning and collecting crew.  
After a great morning we’ll stop in town for lunch before heading to Eighty Mile Beach.  
Accommodation: Eighty Mile Beach Caravan Park including dinner

**DAY 17 – WED 15 JUNE (D)** (375km)

Drive north and into Broome  
Accommodation: Mangrove Hotel (Garden View Rooms) x 2 nights  
Later this afternoon, we’ll head over to Cable Beach to witness one of their famous sunsets  
Dinner at Matso’s Brewery

**DAY 18 – THU 16 JUNE (D)**

Free day in Broome  
Dinner at Mangrove Hotel where we expect to see the “Staircase to the Moon”!

**DAY 19 – FRI 17 JUNE (D)** (217km)

Travel via Kooljamin Cape Leveque to Cygnet Bay Pearl Farm.  
Kooljamin is the Bardi Aboriginal Name for the tip of the Dampier Peninsula.  
Accommodation: Cygnet Bay Pearl Farm – glamping tents x 2 nights

**DAY 20 – SAT 18 JUNE (D)**

“Waterfall Reef” Boat Tour (included) & Afternoon “Giant Tides” Boat Tour (included)

**DAY 21 – SUN 19 JUNE (D)** (428km)

Head to Derby via Beagle Bay to see the ‘Mother of Pearl’ Church.  
Overnight at Derby Lodge  
Dinner at Spinifex Hotel Restaurant

**DAY 22 – MON 20 JUNE (D)** (292km)

Travel via Windjana Gorge & Tunnel Creek and drop into ‘the Inn’ before arriving at the Lodge  
Overnight at Fitzroy River Crossing Lodge

**DAY 23 – TUE 21 JUNE (D)** (300km)

This morning enjoy the Geikie Gorge cruise (included) and then we head to Halls Creek for our overnight stay.  
Overnight at Kimberley Hotel, Halls Creek  
Dinner at the hotel

**DAY 24 – WED 22 JUNE (D)** (120km)

This morning, we'll spend some time out at Old Halls Creek before travelling to Purnululu National Park (Bungle Bungles).  
Accommodation: Bungle Bungles Caravan Park x 2 nights  
Bush style dining under the stars

**DAY 25 – THU 23 JUNE (D)**

Today is a full day to explore the Bungle Bungles.....enjoy some walks and perhaps even take a helicopter scenic flight over this magnificent landscape.  
Again this evening, we'll enjoy bush style dining under the stars!

**DAY 26 - FRI 24 JUNE (D)** (280km)

Today we head to Home Valley Station via the El Questro turnoff & over the Pentecost River.  
Overnight Home Valley Station  
Dinner this evening in Dusty's Bar & Grill.

**DAY 27 – SAT 25 JUNE (D)** (160km)

Dragging yourself away from Home Valley Station you'll travel via back roads to Wyndham to check out the 5 Rivers Lookout and then onto Kununurra via Ivanhoe Crossing.  
Accommodation: Lakeside Resort Caravan Park x 2 nights

**DAY 28 – SUN 26 JUNE (D)**

Some free time this morning before being collected at approximately 11.30am to enjoy a great afternoon on the Ord River with Triple J Cruises (included). \*\* Need to take a sandwich for your lunch.  
Dinner this evening at the Pumphouse Restaurant

**DAY 29 – MON 27 JUNE (L, D)** (70km)

8.30am head to Lake Argyle  
10.15am Lunch Cruise on Lake Argyle (included)  
1.30pm arrive back to Lake Argyle Resort where you'll have time to enjoy the infinity pool that overlooks the lake!  
Overnight in a Lake View Villa
